Though it was not related to our sermon topic on money, we took some time to played a video and discuss its importance as it relates to our sermon series and our values as a church as a whole.

On September 6, 2018, off-duty police officer Amber Guyger entered Botham Jean's apartment, mistaking it as her own. Believing him to be an intruder, Guyger fatally shot Jean. On Tuesday, October 1, 2019, Amber Guyger was found guilty for the murder of Botham Jean. On Wednesday, she was sentenced to ten years in prison. Botham Jean's 18-year-old brother, Brandt Jean, gave the victim impact statement, which can be viewed <u>here</u>.
