VISUAL ARTS

Through a variety of art mediums, Visual Art Campers enter the world of Visual Arts exploring, experimenting, and creating one-of-a-kind treasures. They will discover the creative genius of God and our natural ability to create because we are made in His image.

Grades 1 & 2 - Art Explorers: Enter a studio of creativity in this fun class! Together we'll discover the enchantments of color, line, shape, pattern, and texture, discovering techniques to create our own unique masterpieces.

Grades 3 & 4 – Watercolor Creators: Discover the artist within you! With lines and watercolors, you will make designs as unique as you are. Inspired by the art of Laurel Burch, you'll love this class!

Grades 5 & 6 – World of Art: Watch your inner artist come to life as you explore color, sketch, and create, developing a portfolio as unique as you are.

CULINARY ARTS

Culinary campers will explore and discover how cooking can be one of the world's tastiest art forms. Students in this track will learn some basic food vocabulary, safety in the kitchen, experiment with tools of the trade, and have hands on experience in creating culinary delights.

Grades 1 & 2 – Flavor Explorers: Have a blast exploring sweet, savory, sour, salty, and spicy foods as we make art out of what we eat and eat some of our mouthwatering creations.

Grades 3 & 4 – Dessert Masters: Explore the delights of dessert making, including fruit pizzas, rice Krispie treats, truffles, cake and more!

Grades 5 & 6 – Master Chefs: Come with us as we discover the thrill of cooking in an industrial kitchen, uncover top chefs' secrets, and explore new dishes that you won't be able to wait to taste.

Materials: Closed toe shoes and long pants are required in the kitchen. Hair should be pulled up or back for all classes.



CREATIVE CRAFTS

Creative Craftsmanship artists are not limited to one medium or genre but create from a menu of variety with uncommon and incredible results. From fun, exploratory crafts in Combo Crafters, to challenging and unique projects in Garden Artists and Woodworking Wonders, in this track campers discover the creative genius of God while developing the unique, hands-on skills he gave them.

- *Grades 1 & 2 Combo Crafters: Paper, water, paint, glue, scissors, markers, crayons, tape, and pencils are just some of the tools in this clever crafting environment. Creative expression knows no limits, and neither will you in this hands-on class.
- *Grades 3 & 4 Garden Artists: Creativity begins in the garden! Have fun learning about plants and how many foods grow, develop, and plant your own plot of earth, and create individual take home garden art. Unearth your green thumb here!
- **Grades 5 & 6 Woodworking Wonders:** Get your hammers out and get ready to build wood masterpieces with our woodworking masters. Learn the art of sanding, cutting and assembly your own wood projects, and bring something you made with your own hands home at the end of the week.
- *Materials: Students should wear old clothes and/or bring a paint shirt to protect clothing for some classes. Some projects may be messy! Closed toe shoes are a must for Woodworking.

PERFORMING ARTS (INCLUDES DANCE, THEATRE, AND MUSIC)

Welcome to the exciting world of the performing arts, specifically Dance, Theater and Music.

Creative Dance - Grades 1 & 2 & 3: Do you dream of dancing? Have fun while exploring movement through dance. We will use our imaginations, explore our feelings, and build a foundation and love of dance.

Dance - Grades 4 & 5 & 6: If music makes you want to move, then this class is custom made for you. Have fun while learning more about motion, movement, and how your body was made to dance!

Music - Grades 4 & 5 & 6: Music Magic happens here! Together we will gain basic music knowledge while discovering how God's world is filled with sound and you can be a part of the music making. The instruments we will use are hand chimes and other percussion instruments. While the class will together create a performance piece, the love music sparked during the week will last a lifetime.



Theater - Grades 3 & 4 – The Actor's Studio: Actors in the making, this space is for you! We'll use our imaginations as we explore different scenes and situations, expand our senses while working with others, and grow our characters culminating in a tons-of-fun performance.

Theater - Grades 4 & 5 & 6 - Puppet Masters: Explore the art of puppetry, from creating puppets to bringing them to life, to engaging in hilarious, bantering fun. This class has limited slots available, so for lots of hands-on fun, sign up early.

*Materials: For dance classes, different types of dance shoes may be suggested but are not required. Socks are preferred to tennis shoes or bare feet. Clothes should be comfortable but form fitting. This allows the teacher to be able to see what the child's body is doing during movement. No bare midriffs please. Long hair should be pulled up or back.
